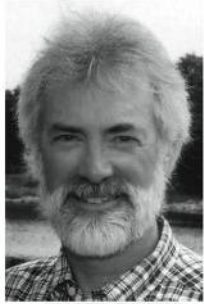

Five Years of Friends Helping Friends



At admissions gatherings with prospective parents, I often point out that Friends School of Portland was started by members of Portland Friends Meeting and is supported by many Friends and friends throughout the country because of their commitment to Quaker education. Each year, beginning with the year prior to our opening, FSP has been able to exceed its dreams thanks to the generosity of so many people. We are typical of most independent schools in this regard: tuition income pays 75-80% of the operating costs annually. The remaining amount must be raised

through grants, fundraisers, and individual donations. The latter is the biggest source of those revenues.

We are not typical in that virtually every dollar raised goes to financial assistance to make FSP accessible to families with diverse financial situations. Our tuition assistance represents 26% of gross tuition income. Typically that number is around 11% for independent schools, nationally. We are not typical in terms of participation in our Annual Fund by every constituent group. While 100% of the directors is commonly expected, it is not always achieved. 100% of faculty is amazing and 79% of parents is astounding. We should all be proud of and grateful for the generosity that sustains this school.

That said, the pride and gratitude would be hollow if those feelings did not extend to the school community that has been created and is sustained by those gifts. As we immerse ourselves in the self-study for accreditation, we are reminding ourselves of how much we have accomplished in less than five years, starting with being true to our mission which is based on Quaker values and practices. That is not to say we have reached perfection. We haven't, nor will we, but together we have created a school in which we practice inquiry, reflection, and action to continually improve ourselves as a school. We continue to model those practices and expect them from our students because we believe that is the path to becoming an informed, critical thinker, and a positive contributor to goodness in the world.
