Enrollment Deposit

- To reserve a spot at Friends School for the upcoming school year, the non-refundable enrollment deposit is due February 27 for returning students and March 21 for new students (or 15 days after notification of acceptance).

Single Payment Plan

- Tuition for the entire academic year is due in full by July 1.
- Any delinquent or unpaid bills as of August 1 will be shifted to FACTS Management Company, Inc. Deferred Payment Plan, with 7 monthly payments beginning August with the final payment due in February. An extended payment fee of 4% will be added to any balance as of August 1.

Two Payment Plan

- One half of the tuition is due by July 1.
- The remaining half plus a 4% extended payment charge is due by January 1.
- If the first payment is late, the balance will be shifted to the Deferred Payment Plan of FACTS Management Company.
- An additional late charge of 1% will be added each month to the unpaid balance as of February 1.

Ten-Payment Plan

- Ten monthly payments will begin in May with the final payment due in February.
- An extended payment fee of 4% will be added to the total tuition.
- Friends School of Portland has contracted with FACTS Management Company to process all monthly tuition payment plans.

Tuition Assistance

To Qualify

- A student must be currently enrolled or applying for admission the following year in full day programs, grades K-8 only. Financial aid is not available for preschool.
- There must be a demonstrated need for tuition assistance according to the financial statements required for consideration.
- If an outstanding balance exists, tuition assistance will be withheld until the account is settled.
- Preference is given to currently enrolled families and children of Quaker families.

To Apply

- Register for the FACTS Financial Aid Assessment online at factsmgt.com.
- Submit the completed application to FACTS, which will provide FSP with an assessment of each family's resources and ability to contribute to tuition expenses. Deadlines for the 2018-19 school year: January 31 for current families and February 13 for new applicants.

Admission and tuition assistance decisions are made separately with one having no bearing on the other. The aid decision is made after the admission decision. The Financial Aid Committee makes all decisions regarding tuition assistance in accordance with Friends School policy.
